The volunteer understands the activities may include but not be limited to handling animals, cleaning cages, walking dogs, changing food and water dishes, attending adoption and fundraising events, sending mailers, participating in fundraising/food/supply drives, soliciting donations, working at various rescue locations, serving as or working with animal foster facilities, transporting animals from one location to another (of driving age and having a valid license) and other duties and activities as the need arises. The volunteer hereby freely, voluntarily and without duress executes this Release under the terms below:

- 1. <u>Release and Waiver</u> Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless CAWL and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind of nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereinafter arise from Volunteer's activities with CAWL.
- 2. <u>Medical Treatment</u> Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge CAWL from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection to the Volunteer's activities with CAWL.
- 3. <u>Assumption of Risk</u> The Volunteer understands that the activities include work that may be hazardous to the Volunteer, including but not limited to, handling frightened animals, cleaning feces, urine and vomit, moving cages and crates, bending, stooping, walking dogs, transporting, and other activities involved in the handling and care of animals. Volunteer hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in the activities and releases CAWL from all liability of injury, illness, death, or property damage or loss resulting from the activities directly or indirectly.
- 4. <u>Photographic Release</u> Volunteer does hereby grant and convey unto CAWL all right, title, and interest in any and all photographs, images, and video, audio recordings made by CAWL during the Volunteer's activities with CAWL, including but not limited to any royalties, donations, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings. Volunteer further permits CAWL to publish said images, recordings and videos, at will on the website and in other media for advertising and other use as CAWL deems appropriate, without additional permission.
- 5. Other Volunteer expressly agrees that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Maryland and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the law of the State of Maryland. Volunteer agrees that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidation of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of the Release, which shall continue to be enforceable.
